Tour 5. Palazzo Pitti: power, art, and enchantment - Pitti & Boboli

Behind the majestic façade of Palazzo Pitti lies a world of splendor, art, and secrets. Once home to grand dukes, queens, and collectors, this palace is far more than a museum: it's a journey into the very life of the Florentine court, through richly decorated rooms, masterpieces of art, and collections that tell centuries of power and passion.

Palazzo Pitti was the royal residence of three dynasties: the magnificent Medici, their successors the Habsburg-Lorraine, and finally the House of Savoy, who lived here as the kings of Italy from 1865. Today, Palazzo Pitti is a universe of art and history, hosting five museums that reveal centuries of passion and masterful creativity: from the Treasury of the Grand Dukes to the Museum of Russian Icons, from the Palatine Gallery with masterpieces by Raphael, Titian, and Caravaggio to the Imperial and Royal Apartments, and also the Gallery of Modern Art and the Museum of Fashion and Costume.

And when you want a change of pace, just take a stroll through the Boboli Gardens—a green masterpiece weaving statues, fountains, and breathtaking views over Florence, offering an oasis of beauty and tranguility. Please note that visiting the garden is optional, and tickets must be purchased separately at the quest's discretion.
