Use before, during and after the congress

Quick Guide for Participants

Purpose: The ICAP 2026 Discord is a complementary community space for orientation, networking, informal scientific exchange and practical support. It does not replace the official ICAP 2026 website, registration system, venue information or scientific programme.

First screen: start with #welcome

1. Join the server

Step 1 - Install Discord on desktop/mobile, or open it in a browser.

Step 2 - Create or log into your Discord account.

Step 3 - Use the official ICAP 2026 invitation link or QR code.

Step 4 - Read #rules and #how-to-use-this-server before posting.

2. What you can do here

Receive official updates and daily reminders.

Ask practical questions and find the right support channel.

Meet other participants before and during the congress.

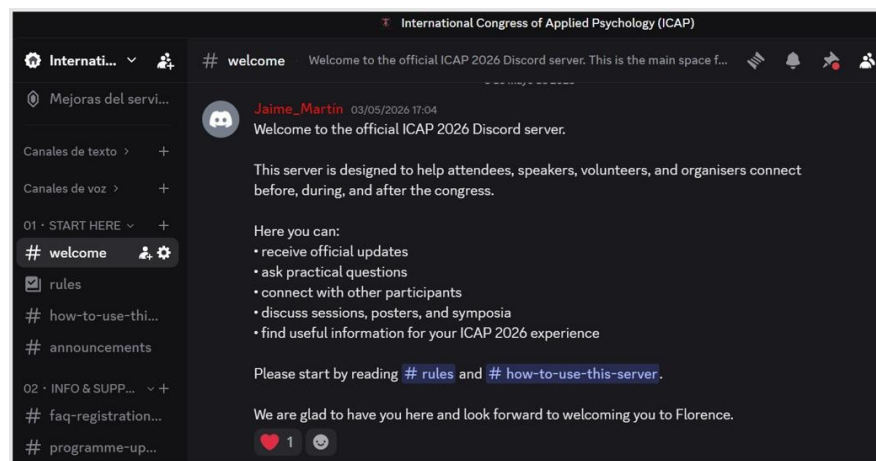
Discuss sessions, posters, symposia and ideas after presentations.

3. What Discord is not

It is not the official programme or registration system.

It is not a clinical, counselling or emergency support space.

It is not the place for spam, mass advertising or private data sharing.



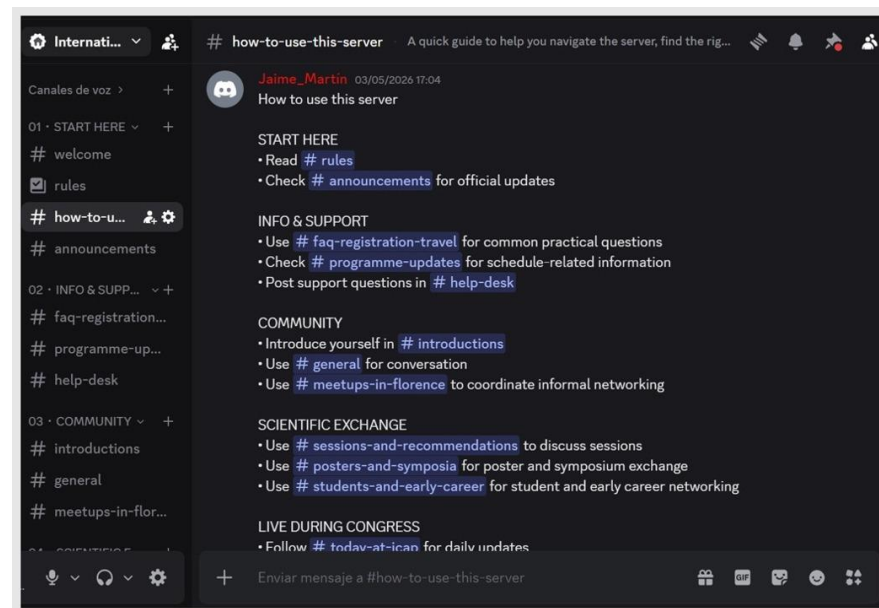
The left sidebar shows the categories and channels you will use.

Server map: where to go

Use the channel that best matches your question. This keeps information easy to find for everyone.

Use #how-to-use-this-server as your map



Some app labels may appear in your own language, but the server content is in English.

What should I post where?

Choose the most relevant channel first. If you are not sure, use #help-desk and the team will redirect you.

Need	Channel	Use it for
Official updates	#announcements	Read only if possible. Check it regularly.
Registration, travel, venue	#faq-registration-travel	Use for common practical questions.
Programme navigation	#programme-updates	Find the official programme link and schedule guidance.
General help	#help-desk	Ask for help when you do not know where to go.
Introduce yourself	#introductions	Name, institution, country, interests and what you hope to gain.
General conversation	#general	Friendly, professional conversation related to ICAP.
Meetups in Florence	#meetups-in-florence	Coffee, lunch, walks and informal networking plans.
Sessions to attend	#sessions-and-recommendations	Share recommendations and discuss scientific sessions.
Posters/symposia	#posters-and-symposia	Tell others what you are presenting or looking forward to.
Students / early career	#students-and-early-career	Networking and questions for students and early career participants.
Daily congress updates	#today-at-icap	Check every congress day for reminders.
Real-time chat	#live-chat	Short updates and live interaction during the event.

How to write useful messages

Be specific. Mention the session, time, room or topic when relevant.

Keep it short. Many people will read Discord on mobile.

Use English. This helps the international ICAP community follow the conversation.

Do not overuse @mentions. Only tag people when truly necessary.

Check pinned messages first. Repeated answers may already be saved at the top of the channel.

Notifications: simple setup

Keep #announcements and #today-at-icap visible during the congress.

Mute channels that are not useful to you if the server becomes busy.

Use the search bar to find a speaker, keyword or previous answer.

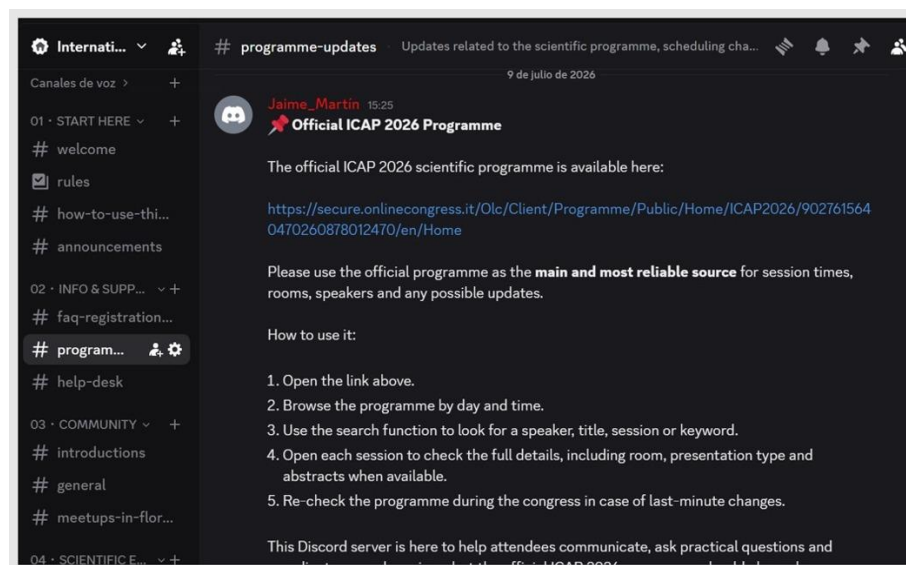
Support rule

For urgent practical issues, use #help-desk. For official programme, room or schedule details, always check #programme-updates and the official ICAP programme.

Programme and scientific discussions

Important: Discord helps you communicate around the programme, but the official ICAP 2026 programme remains the authoritative source for times, rooms, speakers and updates.

Official programme: use this first

Tip: search by speaker, title, session or keyword. Re-check during ICAP in case of last-minute changes.

Community, privacy and respectful conduct

ICAP Discord is part of the congress environment. Use it as you would use an international professional event space.

Core rules to remember

- Be respectful and professional.
- Use channels for their intended purpose.
- No spam or excessive self-promotion.
- Respect privacy and consent: do not share screenshots, personal data or private conversations without permission.
- Follow moderator and organiser guidance.

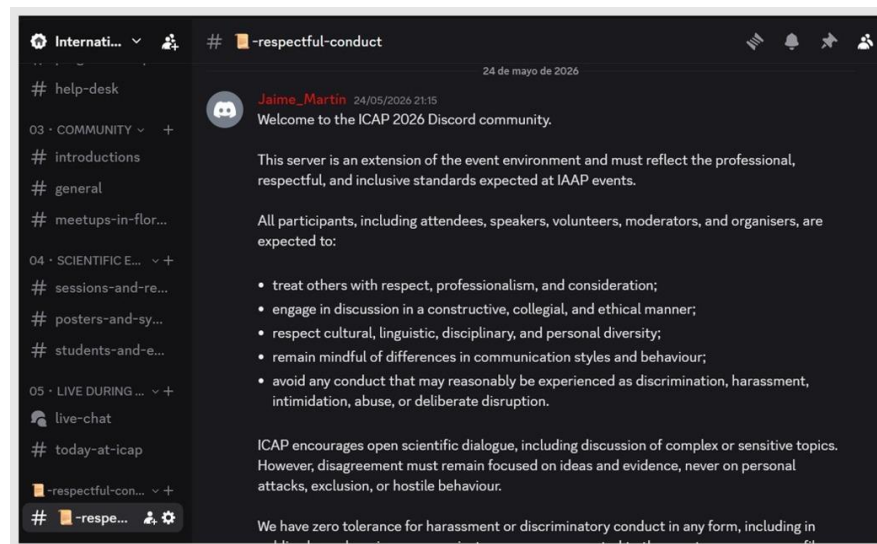
Good networking behaviour

- Introduce yourself clearly.** Name, institution, country and research/practice interests.
- Invite, do not pressure.** Meetups should be optional and inclusive.
- Keep disagreement scientific.** Focus on ideas, methods and evidence, not personal attacks.
- Stay relevant.** Keep posts connected to ICAP, applied psychology or congress logistics.

If something feels wrong

- Do not argue publicly with the person involved.
- Save relevant context if needed, but do not repost private material publicly.
- Contact the moderation team, the organising team or an IAAP/ICAP representative.
